Position Description – Club Coach

Overall Roles and Responsibilities

The Coach provides a pathway for all Club members to advance their sailing or sailing administration skills beyond that provided by the Training Centre and the co-ordination of all coaching activities undertaken by Club members.

Reporting

This position reports to the Training Committee via the Training Centre Principal.

Responsibilities

The specific responsibilities of the Club Coach include:

- 1. deliver coaching programs or arrange for appropriate programs to be delivered either at the Club or other facility.
- 2. provide a pathway for sailors to advance their skills in sailing at either a competitive or social level and providing structured coaching plans for those interested
- 3. provide a pathway to enter into advanced training options for race management or Club sailing administration

Reports

The Club Coach reports to the Training Committee.

Appointment Process

The Club Coach is appointed by the Training Committee on the recommendation of the Training Centre Principal after an interview process.

The Club Coach must have the following skills, attributes and qualifications:

- Demonstrated administrative ability; time availability; sailing ability and Victorian unrestricted drivers licence (or capable of towing a trailer).
- The Coach should be a good communicator who is enthusiastic and approachable as well as being energetic and self motivated. Some level of commercial acumen is preferable.
- Accredited Yachting Australia Club Coach.
